



HOW TO PARTICIPATE ?

All projects must be submitted online in English via the website. Projects submitted by postal mail or via other channels will not qualify for the **Pfizer Oncology Award**.

Projects can be submitted as from July 15th until Sept 30th at latest (closing at midnight). After this date no additional projects will be taken into consideration.

Applicants can only submit their project via **the online application** form and must describe their project within a limited number of 1000 words. It is recommended to first download the application form and fill out your project off line so as to be able to check the accuracy of your text before copying and pasting it on line. Once you have clicked on the "Submit" button you will no longer be able to make annotations. Applicants will be able to submit one project only.

The Award will be distributed by the medical director of Pfizer to the project coordinator at the occasion of the BSMO/Bordet meeting in Brussels on November 24th and 25th, 2017. The award winner will briefly (10 min) present his/her project during this event.

WHAT IS IT ABOUT ?

Pfizer Oncology Award

The yearly **Pfizer Oncology Award** is worth **€ 25.000** and is intended to support, recognise and encourage one innovative project in Belgium or Luxembourg that improves the quality and/or availability of patient care in oncology.

The **Pfizer Oncology Award** is open to any project related to the clinical, surgical and medical or technical aspects of patient care in oncology, but also to different ways of collaboration and/or organisation between various health care providers or between levels of care during the course of the disease.



WHO IS IT FOR ?

The **Pfizer Oncology Award** is inviting health care professionals who are linked to a hospital, a network of hospitals, a university, a certified medical centre or a registered scientific society in Belgium or Luxembourg to submit a project which meets the required criteria (for all details please go to the Rules page on the website).

The project must be developed for improving the quality and/or availability of oncology patient care in Belgium or Luxembourg.

The project may not already be in the implementation phase, but should be in a conceptual or design phase and should start within the year following the distribution of the award.

A set of rules including pre-defined selection criteria has been developed by an independent Scientific Committee who will select the winning project.
